While navigating the largest tributary of the Amazon River, we'll visit and interact with local cultures who must walk 8 hours to the nearest road. We'll hike to ancient ruins and pictograph panels, explore caves and swim in cascading waterfalls, and perhaps most importantly - we'll discuss the devastating impacts that a series of proposed dams on the Maranon would have throughout the region. And we'll do it all in between countless class III and IV rapids.
